### **McGill's Faculty of Medicine Internal Studentships 2016-2017-Apply Now!**

Internal Studentships are open to highly qualified Faculty of Medicine graduate students who are **registered full-time** in a research training program leading to an MSc or PhD degree.

Students who apply for a Faculty of Medicine Internal Studentship are automatically considered for every award for which they are eligible.

#### Value and duration of support

Internal Studentships are tenable for one year starting September 1, 2016. The Faculty of Medicine contribution for an MSc student is \$10,000 and for a PhD student is \$12,000. Supervisors are expected to supplement funded applicants with a minimum contribution of \$8,000.
