Ms. Teri Price

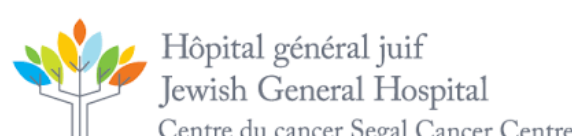
